## Technical Bid

Following documents are required for qualifying in technical bid to be submitted along with part-I technical bid. In no case document will be accepted after opening of EOI/RFP/RFE

- I. Bidder must be reputed manufacturer/Authorised Dealer/Firms/Agency/Govt. or Non-Govt. Organisation/ Companies. (Enclose supporting documents).
- II. It should have at least two year experience in the field of gardening or land scaping or roof top/terrace or horticulture related work. Supporting Work order/ experience certificate issued from Govt. or Non Govt. Organisation should be attached with proposal in support of experience.
- III. Registration Certificate and detailed information of nursery, firm/Company etc should be attached. The Agency must have a demonstration plot and after sale service centre in Jharkhand.
- IV. The bidder should furnish a self-attested copy of PAN & GST registration with their application.
- V. The last three year average annual turnover of the agency/firm must not less than Rs. 10.00 Lakh, Audited Balance sheet along with the I.T Return for the last three financial year should he attached along with E.O.I/RFP. RFP.
- VI. An undertaking (self-certificate) that the bidder hasn't been blacklisted by a central/state government institution and that there has been no litigation with any government department on account of similar services must be submitted.
- VII. The agency/firm should furnish earnest money deposit of rupees 50,000.00 (fifty thousand) only in the form of bank draft in favour of District Horticulture officer Latehar, payable at latehar

**General terms & conditions for Establishment of floral garden in vacant land/ terrace available with households in urban areas and adjoining urban areas & government premises: -**

**Agency/firm must submit proposal for all the components of Establishment of floral garden in vacant land/ terrace available with households in urban areas, adjoining urban areas & government premises together.**

1. Two or more agency/firms of different name & of different registration no. etc. having are person as director or member of the board of director/proprietor/owner have restricted to submit this E.O.I/RFP proposal by the name of both or more firms.
2. The Part-I Technical Bid along with earnest money in form of bank draft, E.O.I/RFP bid document, and the Part-II Financial Bid (Annexure – VI) should be sealed and submitted by the agency/firm in separate envelopes duly super scribed as Part-I Technical Bid and Part-II Financial Bid, respectively and should be put in a bigger envelop super scribing “E.O.I/RFPfor fixation of rate for supply of Establishment of floral garden in vacant land/ terrace available with households in urban areas and adjoining urban areas & government premises in 2024-25” and addressed to the District of Horticulture Office, Combine Agriculture Building, Kinamar, Latehar, 829206 the agency/firm should also super scribe on the top of the bigger envelope the E.O.I/RFP notice no.
3. E.O.I/RFP bid document can be sent by post/courier/or by hand.
4. The last date for submission of E.O.I/RFP document will be on or before 20.12.2024 and the

Bid will be opened on 21.12.2024 before the duly constituted committee. The bidder or his authorized representative may remain present during the opening of such bid. E.O.I/RFP Bids received late after due date and time, will be summarily rejected. The District of Horticulture Office, Latehar will be in no case responsible for late delivery or non-delivery of E.O.I/RFP Bid due to postal delay etc.

5. The bidder should submit earnest money of Rs. 50,000.00/- (Fifty Thousand Only) in the form of bank draft in favour of **District Horticulture Officer, Latehar**, payable at Latehar. and along with E.O.I/RFP/RFP. Proposal, failing which the E.O.I/RFP/RFP will be summarily rejected. Earnest money of the unsuccessful agency/firm will be refund after rejection of their proposal and will be retained from the successful firm up to the ending period of time of execution of contract as security deposit.
6. Contact no., e-mail and full address of the bidder must be clearly mentioned in E.O.I/RFP/RFP. Proposal.
7. In the event of any complaint regarding after sales service and in case of supply of defective/substandard material, the selected firm shall have to rectify the defects within a period of 15 days. The firm must have a service centre with qualified technical staff in the state.
8. E.O.I/RFP/RFP proposal submitted without relevant papers/documents will be rejected.
9. The District Horticulture Office, Latehar is free to evolve strong punitive measure against erring companies to safeguard the interests of beneficiaries in order to ensure proper utilization of public funds.
10. Component material should be as per the quality specifications mentioned in Annexure- VI of the proposal documents. Failure to supply as per the quality specifications shall result in forfeiture of earnest money/security deposit, blacklisting and legal action against the agency/firm.
11. Bidders or their duly authorized representatives may be present at the time of opening of Part-I Technical Bid and Part-II Financial Bid at District of Horticulture Office, Latehar.
12. All the E.O.I/RFP documents should be signed by the authorized person, carrying the prescribed letter of authority and his full name and status should be indicated below his signature with the seal of agency/firms per Annexure-I. It is mandatory for bidder to mention serial number on each page of E.O.I/RFP document. The all pages of E.O.I/RFP Bid document must be signed by authorized person with stamp.
13. Conditional E.O.I/RFP bid proposal will not be accepted.
14. The PART-I Technical Bids will be opened first and will be evaluated by the E.O.I/RFP evaluation committee at the District of Horticulture Office, Latehar Only such proposal will be evaluated in which required Earnest Money deposited along with the Technical Proposal and that meets other conditions of the proposal. Evaluation of the Technical Proposal, shall be carried out by a committee which shall look into compliance of specifications and of other conditions of E.O.I/RFP enquiry. At the second stage, Financial Proposal of only technically acceptable offers complying with E.O.I/RFP conditions will be opened, for further evaluation.
15. Rate quoted in Part-II Financial Bid must be inclusive of all taxes, freight for destination etc. Financial bid will be quoted in figures as well as in words. In case of any ambiguity amount quoted in words will be considered. The quotation of rate of any component must be with respect to desired technical specification of that component mentioned in E.O.I/RFP paper. Bidders should must mention the Quantity of the components proposed for along with financial bid.

16. Since the E.O.I/RFP has been invited for rate fixation, so the rate submitted by any firm found to be the lowest will be the final rate per unit of supply. However, another agency/firm can be empanelled for the items subject to agree to supply the items in the lowest fixed unit rate. All the selected agency/firms shall follow that lowest fixed rate, provided this rate per unit should not exceed the maximum permissible cost.
17. Supply order will be released to the enlisted agency/firm as per choice of the beneficiary by the competent authority. Payment to the supplier will be made by beneficiary/competent authority as per accordance of the government guidelines issued. No interest will be payable on the delayed payment by the competent authority. No claim will be entertained afterwards for any increase in the market price or otherwise.
18. Participation in the E.O.I/RFP bid will automatically imply the acceptance, on part of the participating agency/firm of all the terms and conditions of this E.O.I/RFP/RFP
19. The firm shall submit an affidavit from notary public on Non-Judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100.00 with Part-I Technical bid mentioning that the "agency/company/firm or its sister company/firm & any of its director/ office bearer/authorized agent should neither be convicted by any court of law or blacklisted by any Government/Semi Government concern nor has any named FIR, criminal case regarding misappropriation/defalcation of Govt. fund pending against such or its sister concern by any Government "otherwise such E.O.I/RFP bid will not be considered. In no case above affidavit will be accepted after opening of E.O.I/RFP/RFP
20. The District evaluation/tender committee, reserves the right to verify, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above or to reject any or all the E.O.I/RFP/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or may terminate the E.O.I/RFP/Reprocess midway without assigning any reason.
21. Binding Clause: All decisions taken by the District evaluation/tender committee regarding the processing of this E.O.I/RFP and award of empanelment shall be final and binding on all concerned parties.
22. Delivery: Executing agency must deliver the all materials at the site of beneficiary without any extra transportation charge in the state of Jharkhand.
23. Quantity: The physical target will be determined by the Government order time to time throughout the empanelment period. District Horticulture Office shall place the order only as per the actual requirements from time to time.
24. District Horticulture Officer, Latehar reserves the right to reject/cancel the empanelment of agency/firm at any time if he/she is satisfied that it is desirable to do so in beneficiary interest after giving an opportunity of hearing such an applicant. The decision of District of Horticulture Officer, Latehar shall be final and binding.
25. Period of Validity of E.O.I/RFP Bids: The selected bid shall remain valid for the financial year 2024-25. Further extension may be given to the selected agency on satisfactory completion of the given work order.
26. Warranty:- The successful bidder shall give a warranty pots and plastic items for any packaging defects up to delivery of the material at site. Bidder shall agree to replace or repair at his own cost, part or whole bag found defective after receipt of intimation within three days from the undersigned regarding the defects.
27. Resolution of Disputes: The matter regarding any dispute shall be sorted out at the level of the District Horticulture Officer, Latehar. If the dispute persists to remain unresolved then it will be entertained, heard & finalized by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture,

Animal Husbandry and Cooperative, whose decision shall be binding and final upon both parties. Any legal dispute if arises, will be settled at Latehar jurisdiction only.

28. Test certificate where applicable should be furnished and that can be verified from issuing agency. For testing of material, the fee shall be borne by the agency/firm as and when required.
29. All taxes applicable as per government norms.
30. Time Schedule:- The time period stipulated in the purchase order or letter of intent shall be deemed to be essence of the contract.
31. Agreement:- The selected agency will have to enter in to an agreement with District Horticulture Officer, Latehar. The copy to the agreement shall be made available to District Horticulture Latehar, Latehar to the selected agency and to be executed before assigning the supply work oder.
